





16. 14. Did you receive help with your rent or house payment in the past year?






22. 20. Would you use bus service if bus stop locations and schedules worked for you?




28. 26. In the past 12 months, did you or other adults in your household ever cut the size of your meals or skip meals because there was not enough money for food?





30. 28. In the past 12 months, were you unable to feed your children a balanced meal because you could not afford it?





37. 35. Where do you typically go for dental care needs? (Check only one)






